SOLEMN BUSINESS

**Refixing Diets in terms of Section 75C of the
Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995**

The following Direction takes effect from 3 August 2020.

This Direction concerns all cases calling in the first diet courts and solemn trial courts in respect of which the accused in maintaining a plea of not guilty.

In accordance with the power set out in section 75C of the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995 ("the 1995 Act"), the court, of its own accord, hereby discharges diets assigned for week commencing **3 August 2020** until week commencing **31 August 2020** and fixes new diets as follows:

For cases calling in week commencing **3 August 2020**, a new diet will be fixed in week commencing **23 November 2020**.


For cases calling in week commencing **10 August 2020**, a new diet will be fixed in week commencing **30 November 2020** (30 November 2020 is a public holiday in all South Strathclyde Dumfries & Galloway courts).

For cases calling in week commencing **17 August 2020**, a new diet will be fixed in week commencing **7 December 2020**.

For cases calling in week commencing **24 August 2020**, a new diet will be fixed in week commencing **14 December 2020**.

For cases calling in week commencing **31 August 2020**, a new diet will be fixed in week commencing **21 December 2020** (25 December 2020 is a public holiday in all South Strathclyde Dumfries & Galloway courts).

This direction does not apply to those cases where the accused is in custody in relation to the matter for which he or she is scheduled to appear.
