

Glasgow Family Court Business - Peremptory diets

Further to my email message of 10 July, I can now confirm that there will be 3 dedicated courts during August 2020 in which the peremptory diets which are required in family cases will call.

These will take place on 13, 20 and 27 August 2020.

As previously indicated, the party/parties upon whom intimation has been made will be required to attend timeously at the court building for their hearing if:-

- (i) they have not complied with the time limit set out in the interlocutor to give notice that they wish to appear by electronic means (i.e. by telephone conference call); or
- (ii) they have not lodged written submissions.

The sheriff clerk's office will let agents know if the case is not going to call in court as a consequence of the actions of the party/parties upon whom intimation has been made.

If agents do not hear from the sheriff clerk's office they should assume the case will call in court.
