Order Refixing Diets No. 4 of 2021

in respect of

Summary Sheriff Court Criminal Business

[1 – 5 March 2021]

1. In relation to the following categories of summary sheriff court criminal business calling on the dates specified in column A of Schedule 1 to this order (hereinafter referred to as "Schedule 1"), certain diets have been fixed for days which are no longer suitable to the court, namely:

1. All cases calling in the diet courts;
2. All cases calling in the summary trials courts, except (i) those where an accused is remanded in custody in relation to the case calling; (ii) part heard trials; and (iii) those cases set out in Schedule 2 to this order (hereinafter referred to as "Schedule 2"); and
3. All cases calling in the drugs and alcohol courts, except those where the accused is in custody in relation to the case calling.

2. In accordance with section 137ZB of the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1995 ("the 1995 Act"), the court, of its own accord, hereby discharges each of the said diets fixed for the days specified in column A of Schedule 1 to this order and fixes new diets as follows:

1. In respect of all cases calling in the diet courts on the date specified in column A of Schedule 1, a new diet will be fixed for the date specified in column B of the relative row in the Schedule;

2. In respect of all cases in which an accused person has a deferred sentence calling in the same court and on the same date as a trial diet (except (i) those where an accused is remanded in custody in relation to the case calling; (ii) part heard trials; and (iii) those trials set out in Schedule 2), a new diet of deferred sentence will be fixed for the same date as the new trial diet.
3. In respect of all cases calling for trial in the summary trials courts (except (i) those where an accused is in custody in relation to the case calling; (ii) part heard trials; and (iii) those set out in Schedule 2) on the date specified in column A of the Schedule, a new trial diet will be fixed for the date set out in column C of the same row in the Schedule;
4. In respect of all cases calling for any matter other than trial (e.g. a breach proof in relation to a community payback order) in the summary trials courts (except those where an accused is in custody in relation to the case calling) on a date specified in column A of Schedule 1, a new diet will be fixed for the date set out in column D of the same row in the Schedule; and
5. In respect of cases calling in the drugs and alcohol courts (except those where the accused is in custody in relation to the case calling) on a date specified in column A of Schedule 1, a new diet will be fixed for the date set out in column E of the same row in the Schedule.
